The City of Plymouth Downtown Development Authority Board met in a regular meeting on Thursday, November 9.

Chairman Oliver Wolcott announced talks are continuing with Harmonie Park Development to write a contract to develop the Saxton's property. Discussion between attorneys from the city and Harmonie Park will be ongoing.

The DDA Board approved the expenditure of \$20,000 to repair and replace the tree lights along Main St. Staff will develop a plan to repair and replace tree lights throughout the downtown.

Board member Bob Parent, owner of Sun & Snow, presented the DDA with a \$1,500 check that will be used for the downtown lighting program. The money is the culmination of donations from those who participated in the Wednesday Night Workouts in Kellogg Park during the summers of 2016 and 2017.
