### Ghosts of Plymouth Walk

- Meet and greet some of the characters from Plymouth's past during the Plymouth Historical Museum's "Ghosts of Plymouth" walk, Sunday, June 29 at 7 p.m. Hear the tales of early Plymouth from the characters themselves, such as Phil Markham (inventor of the Markham Air Rifle), his mistress Blanche Shortman, and his spurned wife Carrie, colorful physician Dr. Luther Peck; and George Starkweather, the first white male born in Plymouth Township.

### **A Kids' Eye View of the Civil War--History Kids Kamp**

- Save the date! The Plymouth Historical Museum will hold its third annual History Kids Kamp on Saturday, July 26, from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. Children can experience aspects of the Civil War by recreating what life was like during the war, including dressing in period clothing, getting their picture taken, as well as a chore race consisting of old-fashioned tasks from the mid-1800s. There will also be a scavenger hunt, which will entertain and educate while they search for clues to solve a puzzle. Children will be able to chat with Civil War soldier reenactors who can answer questions, demonstrate marching, and much more. The boys will be given the opportunity to "enlist" in the army.

### **Emergency Food Available June 19**

- The next distribution of emergency food by Plymouth Community United Way is scheduled Thursday, June 19. The Emergency Food Assistance Program provides low-income Plymouth and Northville residents with canned, non-perishable and perishable items.
- All recipients must pre-register at Plymouth Community United Way, 960 W. Ann Arbor Trail, Suite 2, Plymouth.
- This is a supplemental food program that may be used in addition to other assistance programs. Bridge Card holders automatically qualify, but need to pre-register. Recipients not currently on governmental assistance (food stamps, ADC and general) must provide documentation including proof of income and residency before receiving food on distribution days.
- Distributions continue the third Thursday of each month from 9:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. at St. Kenneth Catholic Church in Plymouth.
