According to the latest [Executive Order from Governor Gretchen Whitmer](#), stores that had been forced to close because they were selling nonessential goods can reopen as long as customers order their goods remotely and pick them up at the store's curb or have them delivered. Bicycle maintenance and repair workers also can return to their jobs. Restaurants and food establishments are also permitted to offer carryout and curbside services.

The list below is an update of the establishments that are open and offering curbside service and/or delivery. Some of the closed establishments are offering online shopping. Some are closed until the governor's Executive Order is expired. Consider purchasing a gift card from an individual business as a great way to support our local establishments.


