The festival is a great way to celebrate the fall season and enjoy all that Plymouth has to offer. For more information about this great Plymouth tradition, check out our feature article on page 5!


The DDA Mission

Saxton's Lot Constructuion Continues

The municipal parking lot on the corner of Ann Arbor Trail and Deer, commonly known as the Saxton's Lot, is closed for reconstruction. Crews are installing a new underground water detention system and performing a complete reconstruction of the lot. There will be new EV charging stations and other amenities included in the new parking lot.

Persons who regularly park in the 8-hour Saxton's Lot can find parking in other 8-hour locations including the nearby East-Central lot located between the Penn Theatre and the Library, or the upper level of the Central Parking Deck. A parking map can be found at www.downtownplymouth.org/maps. All on-street and municipal lot time restrictions will remain in effect during the construction project.

A majority of the construction on the lot

is expected to be completed by mid-September, with beautification work continuing through the end of the month. Construction will continue on the adjacent town homes and surrounding areas throughout the reconstruction of the municipal lot.




