# INFRASTRUCTURE SNAPSHOT

Central Parking Deck Construction

Expected to Begin in Late August, Early September

The Plymouth DDA Board of Directors is expected to award the bid for the 2024 Central Parking Deck maintenance project at their August 12 board meeting. Construction is anticipated to begin in late August, with the majority of the work taking place after Fall Festival in September.



Water drainage issues are expected to be addressed on both the pedestrian bridge leading to Main Street, and also near the western stairwell near the medical center. Closures to both the pedestrian bridge and the western stairwell can be expected at some point during the project.

In addition, there will be some tee stem, minor concrete, and other drainage repairs as part of the 2024 project. Although a few parking spaces may need to be blocked during the project, major disruptions to parking are not expected during this project.

Although annual inspections of the deck dictate the needed work, the next major renovation project on the Central Parking Deck isn't expected to take place until 2026.






The DDA Mission


