From the Desk of the Director

The Plymouth Downtown Development Authority and City administration are working toward updating the valet parking policy in Downtown Plymouth. Valet service has the potential to free up spaces in the public parking system, which falls under the “Improve Parking” goal in the current DDA strategic plan. This past August, a Downtown Plymouth restaurant requested the ability to begin valet services and park cars in a private lot on the outskirts of the downtown district.



As staff began looking at the current policy, it was obvious that an update to the policy was needed prior to any approvals. No valet services have been utilized since 2016 in Downtown Plymouth.

At the September 9 DDA board meeting, staff presented a draft version of the new policy to the DDA board for discussion. That draft can be found here: https://downtownplymouth.org/AgendaCenter/ViewFile/Agenda/_09092024-184. Public comments on the policy are welcome at dda@plymouthmi.gov or can be made at the October 14th DDA meeting. Administration is working to revise and polish the updated policy and is expected to present a finalized draft to the DDA board at the October DDA meeting. If the DDA board approves this draft, it will then be forwarded to the City Commission for final approval consideration.

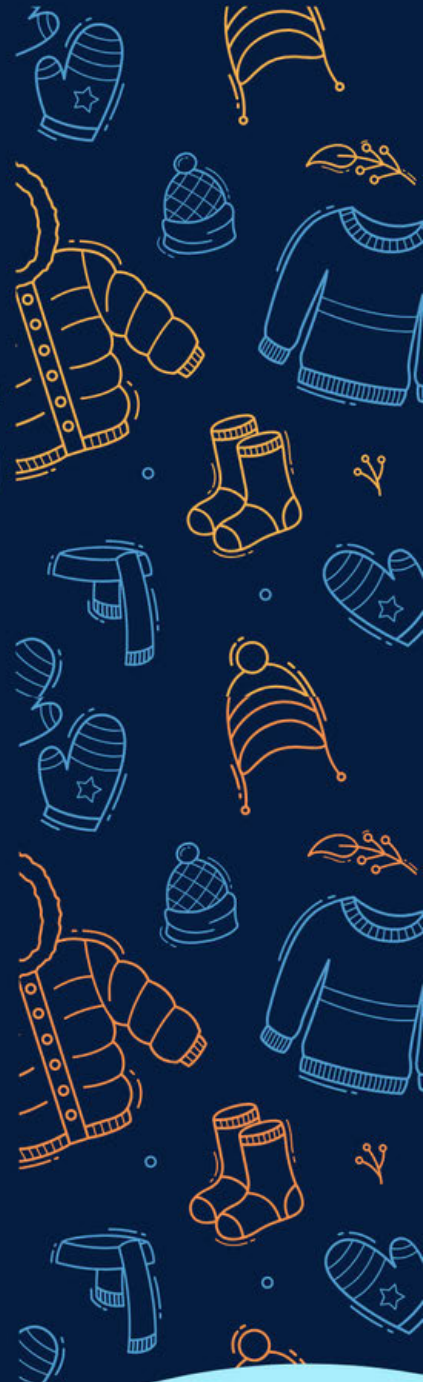

INFRASTRUCTURE SNAPSHOT

Parking Deck Construction Expected to be Completed This Month

RAM Construction is working to complete drain work and concrete patching on the Central Parking Deck in early October. Work early this month will primarily be on the drainage areas near the Main Street pedestrian bridge near the rear entrance to Compari's.

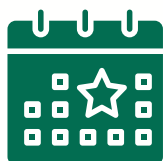


During this final phase of work, there may be disruptions to pedestrian traffic on the walkways from the Central Parking Deck toward Main Street. In addition, a portion of the Fleet Street alley will be blocked as crews do underground work. Motorists and pedestrians are asked to use caution in and around the area.

Crews will also be finalizing drain work on the western stairwell near the Trinity Medical Center. Although the stairwell is expected to reopen on September 28, crews may have to close the area in short intervals as they apply sealant to the area during the first week of October.

These short term disruptions in and around the Central Parking Deck will ensure that the deck remains safe during the winter months and beyond. The next major renovation project on the deck is not expected until 2026.
