From the Desk of the Plymouth DDA Director

The Plymouth DDA has gathered proposals from various design firms for upgrades to the Downtown Plymouth streetscape. These proposals include design and plans for community engagement. Upgrading the streetscape is one of the primary goals of the DDA's Five Year Strategic Action Plan. The DDA created and released a 'Request For Proposal' (RFP) back in March with the deadline for submissions being May 1.

DDA and City staff will be working over the next month or so to review the proposals. The DDA Board is expected to award a contract at a DDA meeting this summer.

Once a proposal is chosen, work will begin on a community engagement process that will guide decision making toward final design elements. That process is expected to take up to a year to complete. Updates will be available at downtownplymouth.org as we move forward through the process.

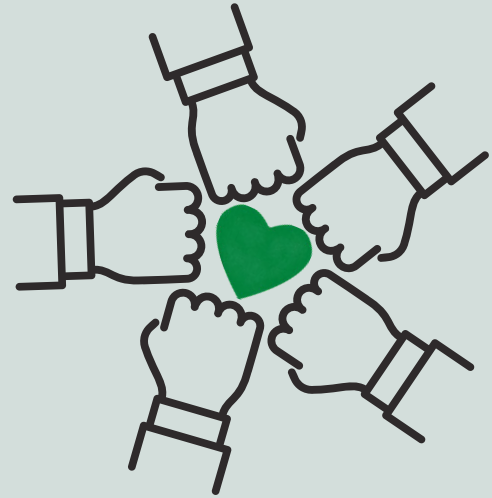

Downtown Plymouth Businesses Rally After Flood Damage

In the early hours of April 3rd, severe flooding impacted a number of Downtown Plymouth businesses. Most affected were businesses on the north side of West Ann Arbor Trail west of Main Street, south Forest Ave, and those off Fleet Street near the central parking deck.

Though it drained quickly, rainwater from the Tonquish Creek rolled in up to 15 inches in some areas. For many storefronts, the backbreaking recovery process included the challenging cleanup of significant mud and debris that the rush of rainwater left as it receded.



The following days saw a flurry of activity behind storefront doors with “Temporarily Closed” signs. As heartbreaking as it was to witness the traumatic results of the flood, what followed demonstrated the rare community we have.

We saw business owners, even while dealing with damage to their own businesses, reach out to offer immediate, effective help to neighboring businesses. Resources, space, contacts were shared. Many took to social media to spread the word about ways to support impacted businesses. Neighbors, friends, customers called, stopped by in person to offer assistance. People walking by stopped to lend a hand.

We see. We care. We DO. This is what makes Downtown Plymouth and the surrounding community extraordinary.
