



DDA Hires SmithGroup to Lead New Streetscape Design

The City of Plymouth and Plymouth DDA have approved a contract with Ann Arbor's SmithGroup to produce a new Downtown Plymouth Streetscape Design. Work is expected to begin in late summer or early fall that will begin with a robust community engagement process.



The DDA identified a need to upgrade Downtown Plymouth's streetscape while completing its strategic planning last year. The original Downtown Plymouth Streetscape project took place in the 1990s, with a refresh completed in 2011-2012. The DDA has identified the following goals related to the project:

- Enhance DDA District Aesthetics & Function
- Improve Parking
- Improve Pedestrian Safety

SmithGroup intends to lead a comprehensive community engagement process over the next nine months that will include surveys, various types of charrettes and other meetings, and various outreach methods including digital. Once the community driven direction for the project is established, SmithGroup will complete a design by summer of 2026. Construction on the streetscape project may begin late 2026, but will most likely begin in 2027. The DDA will have continuous updates on the project's status in this publication and at *downtownplymouth.org*.
